STAFF BIOGRAPHY


Tariq Hassan, M.D.

Dr. Tariq Hassan is the Chief Medical Executive, Associate Director of Patient Care for the Captain James A. Lovell Federal Health Care Center. He was appointed to the position when the facility stood up Oct. 1, 2010.

In his current position, he is responsible for overseeing all medical functions and direction at the health care center.

Dr. Hassan received his M.D. at the Medical School, University of Jordan in 1979. He completed his psychiatry residency in 1984 from the Lafayette Clinic, Wayne State University, in Detroit, MI, and also completed neurology resident at the University of Illinois at Chicago in 1990. He is double boarded in Neurology and Psychiatry.



Prior to his current assignment, Dr. Hassan was the Chief of Staff at the North Chicago VA Medical Center; he was selected to the position September 1997. Before this, he was the Chief of Neurology Service and was also the Acting Chief of Psychiatry Service at the North Chicago VA Medical Center. Dr. Hassan is an Associate Professor of Neurology and Psychiatry at Rosalind Franklin University of Medicine and Science, and the Chicago Medical School.
