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What is Speech Video-To-Home Telehealth?

- Speech Video-To-Home Telehealth uses video, audio, and other information systems to reach Veteran patients in outlying areas. Veterans can see and talk to health care providers without having to travel from home.
- You can expect the same quality care that you would get in person. Your information will be kept private and secure.
- You will be able to see and work with a speech pathologist from the Captain James A. Lovell FHCC. Your picture and other information will be transmitted in real time.

How does Speech Video-To-Home Telehealth work?

- To begin, a complete evaluation will be done in person at the Captain James A. Lovell FHCC.
- Follow-up therapy will be done through Speech Video-To-Home Telehealth. You will need to have a webcam and broadband internet in order to participate.



Ask if Speech Video-To-Home Telehealth is right for you.

- Talk with your speech pathologist. Ask if Speech Video-To-Home Telehealth might be a good fit for you.
- Even if you use Speech Video-To-Home Telehealth, you may choose to be seen in person at any time.
